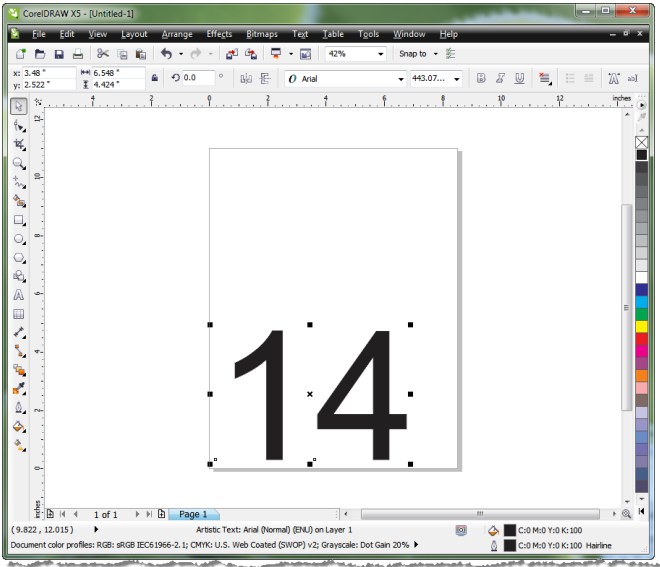


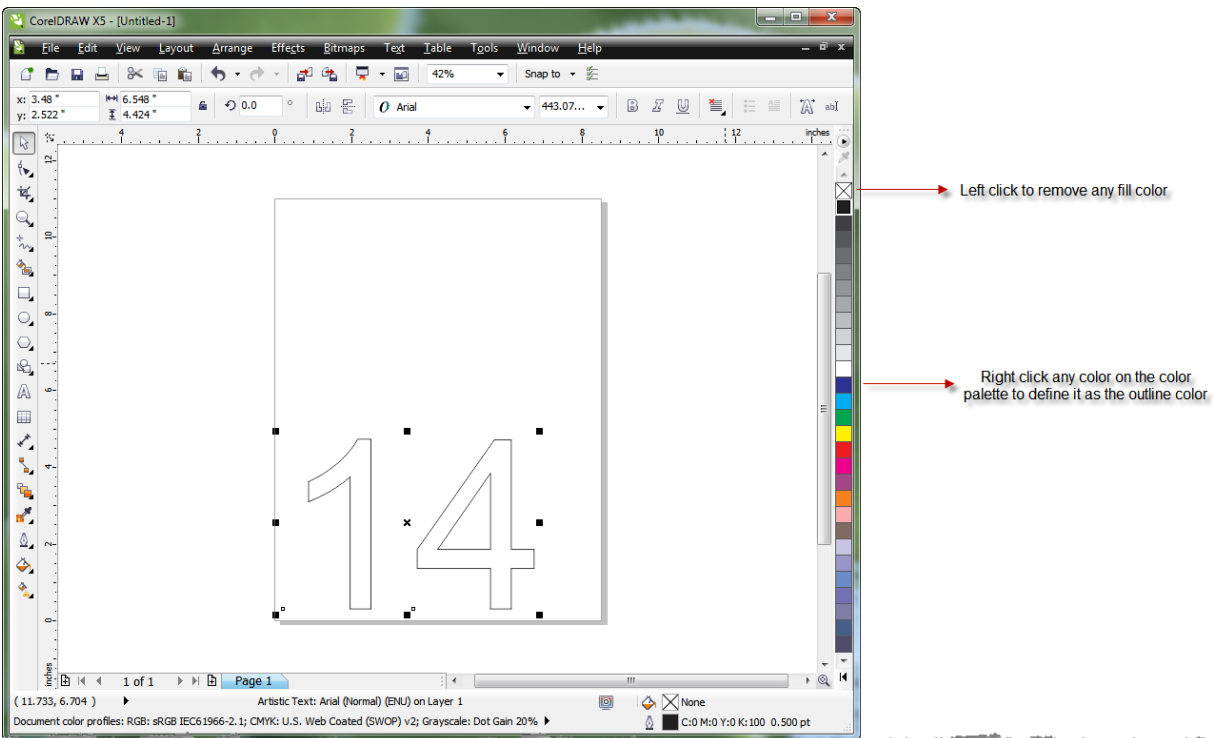


How to Create a Two Color Design in CorelDraw

1. Create design in CorelDraw



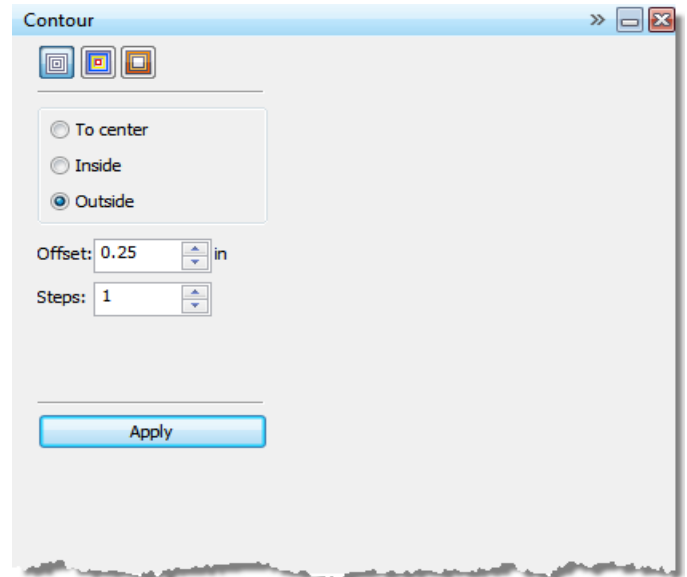
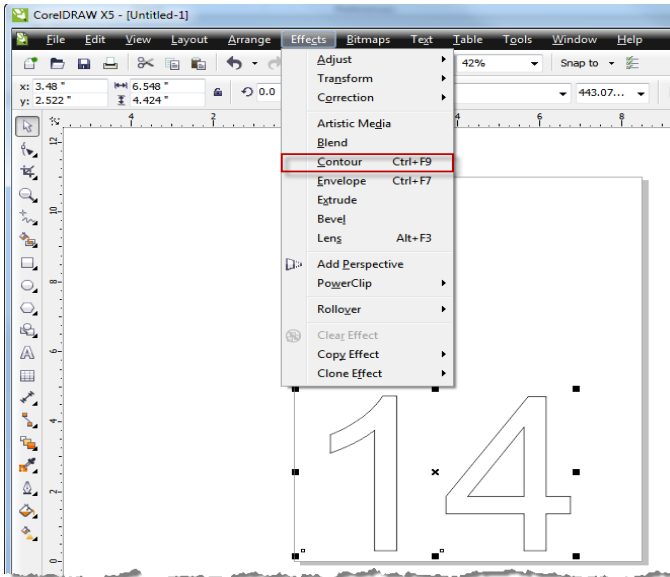
2. Define a color outline and remove any fill color





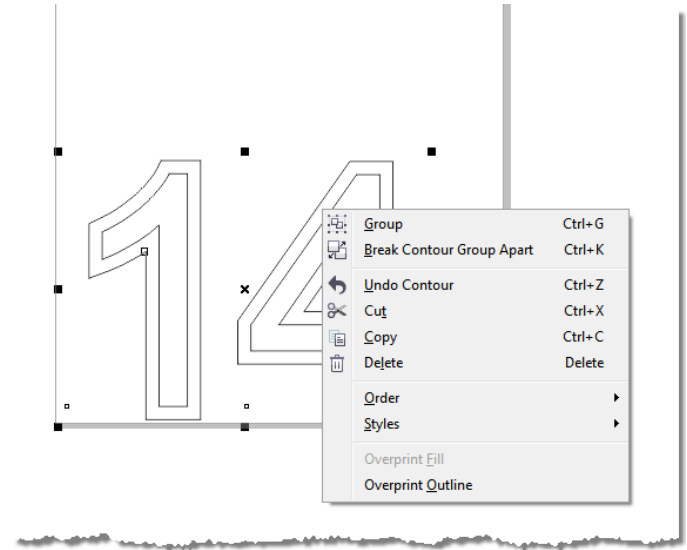
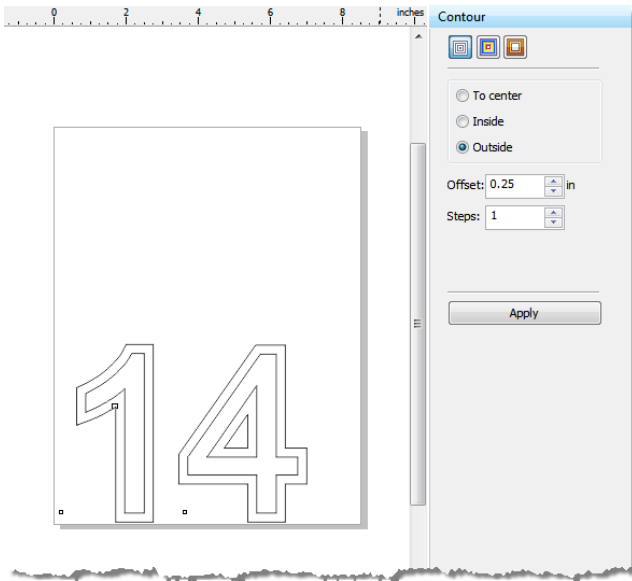
3. From the pull down menus on top of the screen, select Effects then Contour

4. A contour panel should appear on your screen. Select Outside and the desire offset value. Click Apply when done



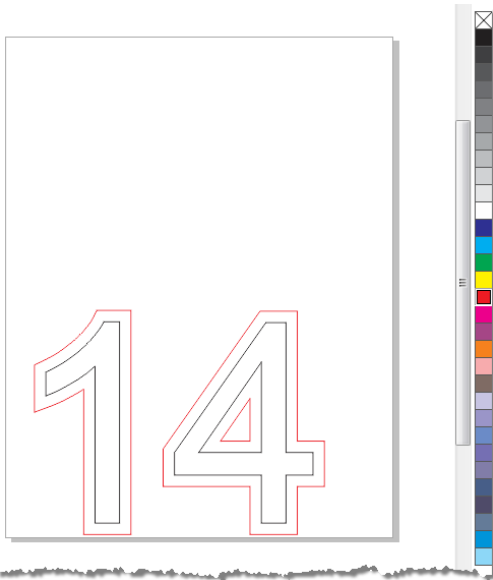
5. The result should be similar to the image below

6. Right click on the image and then select "Break Contour Group Apart". This is needed in order to create a different color for each layer

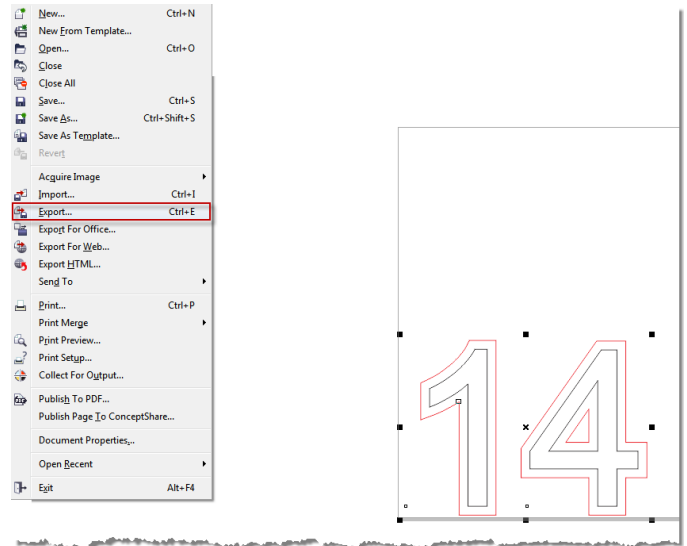




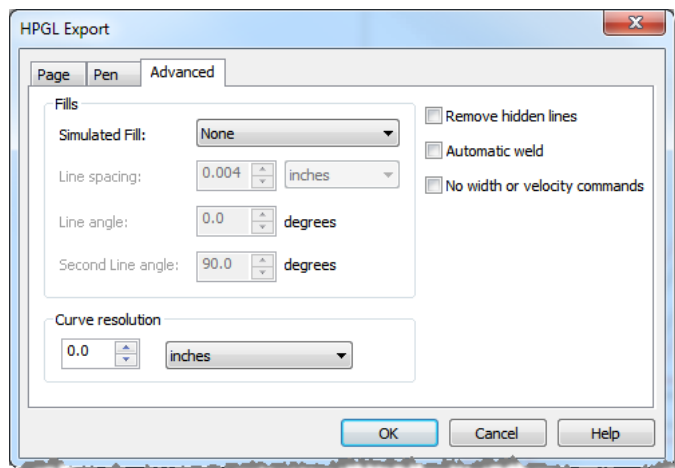
7. On the following example, select the outer layer and right click on a color on the color palette. On this particular case, red was selected



8. Select both layers. Finally, from the pull down menus on top of the screen, click on File, then Export



9. A new export window will come up. Name the file, and click on Export. On the **HPGL Export Window**, click on the Advanced Tab and make sure **Curve Resolution** is set to **0.0** See below



10. When the file is open in the Ioline 301 software, two layers should be visible (make sure to select both layers in the design setup window).
